

The Evolution of Humanity

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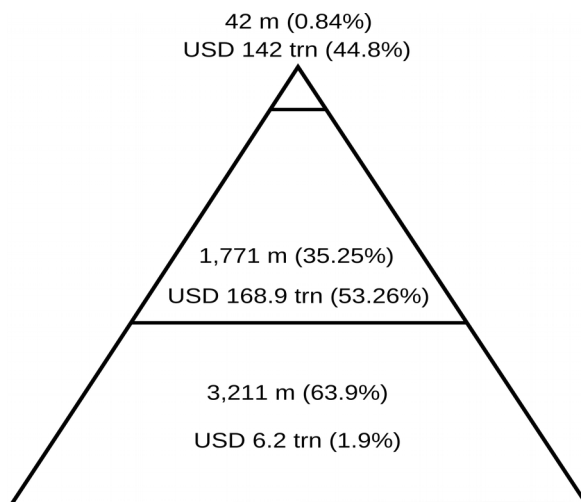


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The Root

The Pyramid

What the diagram shows, is the wealth distribution in our world today, or in 2018 to be precise, where less than 1% hold over 40% of the wealth, and over 60% of the world's population live on 2%.

For me, this is insane ... simply insane!

I can go on and on about how this is not fair or just, and give examples, and build pictures for you to show how such a layout is insane, but ... I won't. I won't because you should already see it, and again, if you don't, then stop reading ... again ... this book is not meant for you!

I'm not an economist, or financial wizard, or hold any degree in global economics, but anyone with a basic knowledge of anything, would see that this is absolutely messed up. And you think that with millions of people across the globe, who work at enhancing your living standards, in all possible ways and all possible direction, especially in the public domain, and yet, with all what everyone has ever learned so far, this is what we have come to! This is what we have achieved! This is the best our minds can reach!!

All what we hear all the time is: "this is for your own good", "this is for a better tomorrow", "this is what you should do for a prosperous world", but what are we getting? The only way I could describe it is: a new form of slavery!

The Machine

Who built it?

Where and when did it come into existence?

Was it modernization or was it industrialism?

Or was it free markets?

I honestly don't know, I'm not a scholar of history, nor have I studied anything more than what one normally studies in college economics 101 or 201, and maybe some 300 levels, but what I do know is what we have come to, and what we are living in today.

I remember the two curves of supply & demand, and their intersecting equilibrium point. I remember the talks about opportunity costs. What I do not remember, is anything about market manipulation, or the greed of nations and corporations. I don't remember anything about the drug industries, and I don't mean the illegal ones. I don't remember anything about financial institutions, stock exchanges, and profits!



The Curve

Supply and demand, which is the basis of today's valuation system for almost all of our resources, is a very solid and fair way to give anything a value. If it's in high demand and it's supply is limited, then it's value goes up, and vice versa. Very simple, and very logical. But what if the announced or declared supply & demand is not the real one. A real demand for let's say apples would be the amount of people who want apples, be it for direct consumption or production of other products, etc. What if the declared supply & demand is manipulated for gains!?

The Plan

The Objective

So the objective is set ... now comes the hard part. We gave the project a name, we stated the objective, now how do we get from here to there?



The Roadmap

A very high level roadmap can always help moving things, it's like a list of milestones for the project. So our road map should be:

- Analyze the objective, and break it down into smaller ones, that can be easier to achieve.
- Build specialized teams, whose task is to devise individual plans for each and every one of these mini objectives.

If I remember correctly, that's your basic waterfall project plan model.



The Consensus

The objective is a very high level statement that needs to be broken down to hundreds of smaller milestones to fulfill. The first milestone is to build the community that will connect people from around the globe together.

Once that is established, the second milestone will be to break this community into groups of specialization, each to work on setting the inner milestones for their perspective fields.

The third milestone will be for these groups to share their outcomes with the rest of the community for a general consensus.

The forth milestone will be to put all these milestones on one plan, and start working on the execution phase.

These four milestones could take a few months, or a few years, depending on how far the people will be willing to work together.



The Paths

There are many paths that can be taken to reach the objective, but my favorite ones are:

1. To build a community that is backed up with its own collected funds, which are then, the funds, invested in buying resources and businesses around the globe.
2. The same idea, but instead of buying businesses, we buy a country!!

The Change

Remember, you want to change the way the world works right now, and there are two ways to get that done, and ironically they both need money!!! The System

Part of the transformation needed, to achieve the objective, will be a system that studies the consumption of every individual. What you eat, drink, wear, medicine you use, books you buy, everything. Think of it like one of those budget management apps, or diet monitoring apps, that we all have on our phones, but this one is on a global scale.

The purpose of this system is to collect enough data over time, to be able to forecast how much you, and everyone on this planet, consume on average.



The Data

We are living the time of big data, and if you are not in the information technology business, big data is the discipline of how to collect and process huge amounts of data in order to provide a better understanding of what such data represents. In spy movies, they call it profiling, where they monitor all your online activity to build a character profile for you, and mostly use it against you :-)



The Information

The Math

Back to the beginning, the pyramid, and nothing is better to explain numbers than to put them right next to each other.

- 3.2 billion people (63.9% of the adult population) hold up to 10,000 USD in wealth, with a total sum of 6.2 trillion USD (1.9% of the total wealth), that's an average of 1,930 USD per person.

- 1.7 billion people (35.2% of the population) hold from 100,000 up to 1,000,000 USD in wealth, with a total sum of 168.9 trillion USD (53.2% of the total), that's an average of 95,369 USD per person.

- 42 million people (0.8% of the population) hold over 1,000,000 USD in wealth, with a total sum of 142 trillion USD (44.8% of the total), that's an average of 3,380,000 USD per person.

The progression of average wealth between these three stages is:

- 49.4 times from 1,930 to 95,369

- 35.4 times from 95,369 to 3,380,000

Would you like to know the number between the 1% and the 60% it's 1,751 times!!!



The Balance

We can talk about equality, and fair wages, and worker's unions, and economic theories, and how we can take from the rich and give the poor, and, and ... but all of that won't do anything to change the math. It won't do because it hasn't done anything so far, and as we all know by now, insanity is trying to do the same thing over and over again, in the same way, and expect different results.

There is no economic reform plan, or social equality plan, or any other plan that will make any real change unless we remove the curse and get rid of money. That is the only way that we can really achieve any form of balance between us.

Wealth has to be a term of the past!



The Climb

Even if the entire 60% put all their wealth together to buy out all the resources, they won't have enough to even buy 2% of it. They pose no real threat to the existing system! But, as soon as the evolution starts attracting more and more from the 39, then, and only then, there will start to be a real challenge to the 1.
